

## Typical office document colour distribution

Black + Useful Colour



Everyday Colour



Expressive Colour

The Hybrid Colour Plan - 3 Tier Billing classifies pages based on the actual amount of colour used. 
Most standard cost-per-copy plans charge you a fixed market rate for black and white pages and a fixed market rate for colour pages. This may be good for full colour coverage or black only documents, but it doesn't take into account that the majority of office colour pages have only low to moderate amounts of colour on the page (see chart below).

#### How it works

The ColorQube family of products create images by printing tiny spots (called pixels) of black and colour on the page. The machine automatically counts how many colour pixels are used to produce each printed page. Individual pages are tallied on three separate meters in the machine based on how many colour pixels are on the particular page.

#### Colour that's easy to afford

The Hybrid Colour Plan combines the affordability of purchasing supplies with the convenience of metered billing.



## Choice of metered plans put you in charge

Black + Useful Colour – Black only pages and pages with low colour coverage are billed at the black only rate. Examples include typical emails, memos and Microsoft Word documents

**Everyday Colour –** Pages with moderate colour coverage are billed at a fraction of the full colour cost. Examples include typical flyers and Microsoft Excel and PowerPoint documents.

Expressive Colour – Pages with high colour coverage are billed at the current market rate for colour. Examples include typical photos, brochures, newsletters and marketing materials.
