Pre-Configuring Default Settings in Standard DC PostScript Print Drivers

Purpose

This document contains information for system administrators, about modifying default settings configured by the PostScript printer description (PPD) file of a standard PostScript print driver. A print driver's default settings are those initialized when you first install it.

When the system administrator modifies the PPD file, new defaults are established. When end users install the driver it is configured for them, bypassing the need to access the printer object Properties and select the Systems Configuration tab to indicate the installable options.

Administrators can also use this information as a tool to enable printing in "thin" (basic or minimal) client environments such as: Windows Terminal Server, Citrix Metaframe and WinCenter.

NOTE: Do not attempt to pre-configure an enhanced print driver using the information in this document.

Printer vendors create PPD files to describe standard features specific to a make and model of PostScript printer. Use a standard editor such as Wordpad or Notepad to edit a PPD file. Before you make any changes, make a backup copy of the PPD file so you can return to the original settings.

Modifying a Document Centre's Configuration

If you plan to edit the PPD file to modify your Document Centre's configuration, do so before you install the print driver.

The list in this section contains Document Centre configuration options you can alter in a PPD file.

- Duplex - True or False (Does the Document Centre have a duplex module?)
- Tray 3 - True or False (Does the Document Centre have paper tray 3?)
- Tray 4 - True or False (Does the Document Centre have a paper tray 4?)
- Envelope Tray - True or False (Does the Document Centre have an envelope tray?)
- High Capacity Feeder – True or False (Does the Document Centre have an HCF?)
- Stacker-Stapler (Finisher) – True or False (Does the Document Centre have a finisher?)
- Tower Mailbox – True or False (Does the Document Centre have a Tower mailbox?)
- LANFax – True or False (Does the Document Centre have fax enabled?)

A sample section follows with all options settings as True. The Duplex section is shown with both True and False settings.

CAUTION: Edit only those portions of the PPD file shown in **bold type**.

Constraints Based on Installable Options

The sample in this section shows a PPD file with two of the most common option modifications: duplex printing is enabled and the banner sheet is disabled.

NOTE: You must enable the duplex module (as shown in the sample in the "Modifying a Document Centre's Configuration" section earlier in this document), before you make other duplex modifications like the one in the following sample.

This line indicates the format of the duplexed pages. Duplex No Tumble flips the duplexed page on the long edge. Duplex Tumble flips the page on the short edge.

This line shows the banner page turned off (False). To turn the banner page on, enter True.
