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Offering exceptional ease of use, impressive multitasking capabilities and very good output quality, the Xerox DocuColor 250 (\$46,495) has been named a Fall 2005 BLI "Pick" as "Outstanding Production Color Multifunctional Imaging System."

This model demonstrated near-flawless reliability, completing its 200,000-impression durability test with no service calls required and just one misfeed. It also proved to be very productive, with rated speeds of 50 ppm in color and 65 ppm in black. While the DocuColor 250 was tested with the Fiery controller, it is also available with two other optional controllers, which gives customers flexibility to match the system's capabilities to their specific requirements.

Contributing to the DocuColor 250's impressive ease of use is the large, color touch-screen monitor, which can be swiveled, tilted and adjusted for brightness.
